

# SPRING CREEK FOREST POOL RULES

1. Entry to the pool area WILL NOT be allowed without a Facility Access key fob. Access key fobs will only be issued to residents in good standing. Any guest(s) MUST BE accompanied by a resident with a key fob. Otherwise, entry will be denied. All patrons using the pool do so at their own risk.
2. Lifeguards are authorized to enforce the rules, regulations, and conditions for use of the pool and pool area. All patrons, including adults, are required to follow the requests and instructions given by the lifeguards. They are there for your safety.
3. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES OF ANY KIND ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED INSIDE THE POOL AREA.** Lifeguards are authorized to require anyone consuming an alcoholic beverage to leave the pool area.
4. **No glass containers** of any kind are allowed inside the pool area.
5. **All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by and closely supervised by an adult age 18 or older**, who is responsible for the behavior and safety of the children that came with them. The lifeguards are responsible for everyone in the pool and are not babysitters. Children who cannot swim must be limited to a water depth no higher than their shoulders and must be within sight of their adult supervision at all times. Children who can swim and wish to venture into the deep end of the pool or use the diving board must be closely supervised by their adult companion. Children unsupervised will be asked to leave the pool until their adult companion can be located.
6. A resident in good standing with an access fob is allowed up to 6 guests at any one time. Residents with guests must register both themselves and their guests on the sign in sheet by the entry. A resident with guests is responsible for the appropriate conduct of their guests. Guests agree to abide by the posted rules and regulations while on the premises.
7. Lifeguards are authorized to evaluate the swimming ability of any child or young adult up to the age of 18. Lifeguards may restrict patrons to certain areas of the pool based on this evaluation, for their own safety and the safety of others.
8. Use of the kiddy pool is intended for children under 6 years old and requires adult supervision at all times. Lifeguards are NOT responsible for monitoring the kiddy pool.
9. Any child not toilet trained must wear an appropriate waterproof swim diaper in either the main pool or the kiddy pool.
10. No running or rough play will be tolerated.
11. Diving from the sides of the pool is NOT allowed. Diving is only permitted off the diving board, where the area is clear of other swimmers and the water is deep enough to prevent injury. Only one person on the diving board at a time. Swimmers should dive straight out into the main body of the pool, not off to the sides.
12. General swimming is not allowed in the diving area, which is marked by the buoy rope across the pool.
13. No intoxicated or disorderly conduct will be tolerated. No loud, abusive, or foul language will be tolerated. Patrons exhibiting any of these behaviors will be asked to leave the pool area. Loud music is prohibited. Patrons will be asked to reduce the volume or leave.
14. Appropriate swim attire is required for all patrons at all times. No cutoffs please.
15. The last 10 minutes of every hour are designated for a lifeguard safety break. All patrons must exit the pool during this time.
16. Cocoa butter, baby oil, or any other heavy tanning oil or lotion are not allowed as damage to filtration equipment may result.
17. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
18. No smoking in the pool area or other common areas.
19. Access key fobs will only work for the pool gate during published resident pool hours. No access is allowed outside of published hours unless special arrangements have been made. Violators will be prosecuted.
20. No plug-in electrical devices are allowed in pool area unless appropriate GFI outlets are available, and then no electrical device should be within 15 feet of the water.
